Haven Heroes Mission Statement: A network of young professional volunteers helping A Child's Haven (ACH) grow by expanding awareness of our mission, advocating for ACH children and families, and raising funds or collecting resources for our programs.

Annual membership: \$120 to join (\$10 per month) – Members will also receive an A Child's Haven stainless steel tumbler.

Commit to two hours per month, participating in at least one of the following:

1) Monthly Meetings:

- Members must attend at least 9 of the 11 monthly meetings at 1 hour each.
- Most meetings will be held on ACH's campus and lunch will be provided. (Meeting times/places can be adjusted)
- Members may call in to meetings if necessary.

2) Fundraisers:

- Small Fundraisers:
 - Facebook Fundraisers (Birthday or Giving Tuesday)
 - In-kind Donations – Diaper/Pull Ups drives, classroom supply drives, clothes drives, etc.
 - Promote Life Lifters campaign - \$10, \$20, \$40 per month (Minimum of \$120 a year.
 - Get your church or office involved by having a bake sale or yard sale
 - Your ideas are welcomed! ACH will provide materials for whatever you need.
- Larger Fundraisers:
 - February Event – THYME and Play partnership dinner for ACH families. February 7th, 5:30pm – 9:00pm
 - Peer to Peer Campaign – Goal of \$8,000 - \$10,000 Early June.
 - 12 ambassadors including HH, ACH staff, BOD, and local businesses will promote ACH and raise funds for the organization.
 - Each ambassador will set their own personal fundraising goal.
 - All social media graphics and “scripts” will be provided!

3) Volunteering: 5 hours per year.
